

Saison Cookies Policy (Effective as of 4 July 2025)

This cookies policy ("**Cookies Policy**") explains how we use cookies and similar technologies (collectively referred to as "**Cookies**") when you visit saison-international.com (each, a "**Site**"), what Cookies are and why we use Cookies, as well as your rights to control them.

What are Cookies?

A Cookie is a small amount of data that is sent to your browser and stored on your computer's or mobile device's hard drive. By using Cookies, websites can save information about visits and visitors. This information may include IP address, as well as the device, browser, and operating system you are using, and your click behaviour, such as the specific pages you visit and how you navigate the Site.

Session Cookies stay in place for the duration of your browser session, while persistent Cookies remain on your device for a pre-defined period. The session Cookies use encrypted data to authenticate you. The persistent Cookies do not store account numbers or passwords.

We do not place Cookies ourselves ("**First-Party Cookies**"), but other Cookies are placed by third party provider(s) whose service(s) we have added to our pages ("**Third-Party Cookies**") to enable third party(ies)'s features or functionalities to be provided on or through the Site (e.g., analytics). Third-Party Cookies may collect data outside our Site as well.

What type of Cookies do we use?

The specific categories Cookies supplied through our Site and the purposes they perform are described in the table below (please note that the specific Cookies served may vary):

How can I control Cookies?

You can change your Cookies preferences or withdraw your consent at any time by opening the '[Settings](#)' at the bottom of all pages on our Site. If you have previously given us your consent but would like to remove the Cookies that we have placed, you can do this by deleting these Cookies via your browser or the settings on your device.

As the means by which you can refuse Cookies through your web browser controls vary from browser-to-browser, you should visit your browser's help menu for more information. If you adjust the privacy setting in your browser, your mobile device will continue collecting data unless you adjust the privacy setting of the device, and vice versa. If you choose to set your web browser or mobile device controls to reject Cookies, you may still use our Site though your access to some functionality and areas of our Site may be restricted.
